Brookfield has a population of approximately 6,000. KGHM, call letters meaning Green Hills of Missouri, is not affiliated with any other station or network, and went on the air February 15, 1956. Our present on the air hours are from 6:00 AM until 6:15 PM. Our frequency checks are made with Commercial Radio Monitoring, in Kansas City, Missouri.

I do not have the information about the history of Brookfield, and how it got its name. If you would write the Brookfield Chamber of Commerce, I am sure they would be glad to oblige you with pamphlets containing that sort of information.
