R A D Thanks very much for your reception report of November 7. Your comment on the three Missouri stations on the same frequency is very interesting.

We're very glad too that you heard us for the first time. We have received reports from lots of other guys (SWLs and hams) since we first began freq checks on our new frequency, too. There were some from Montreal, Canada, Philadelphia, Cleveland, Gastonia, North Carolina and others. The tests you heard came from a non-directional antenna system. This antenna was used on our old frequency and on the old power. The power now is 500 watts. Pretty soon, as you know, we will crank it up to the full 5 gallons. We will then be Southeast Missouri's most powerful radio station, and we will be slightly directional (attenuated to the east). We don't have any coverage maps printed for the big power yet, but if you will sit tight, we'll shoot you one when we get them.
