Dear 'Ern':

We are very happy to issue you this letter of verification of our DX program on December 28, 1949, from 2:19 to 2:32 am, CST. Your report is correct in every detail.

KICK is Gates throughout, with RCA speech equipment and a 176' Lehigh self-supporting tower. Studios, offices and transmitters are in the same building, 5 blocks west of the main business district. We are affiliated with Mutual, the United Press and Standard Program Libraries. KICK has two studios in addition to its control room.

Our schedule is as follows: Daily, 6:30 to 1:00 am, CST; Sunday, 7:00 to 1:00 am, CST; Saturday, 6:30 to 2:00 am, CST. We conduct a monthly frequency check with Kansas City on the 4th Wednesday from 1:20 to 1:35 am, CST. A 500 cycle note is utilized at this time.

We hope that you have received your letter from our Chamber of Commerce -- and in case you're interested, Morss of Bradord, Mass (and NRC) was awarded a letter of congratulations from our city Mayor for receiving us at the greatest distance. You will also find enclosed a picture-snap of our tower and building.
