
Please accept this letter as verification of your report of November 23, 1966, at 12:30 a. m. I am very pleased to receive your report. I get quite a lot of QSL's from members of your club.

KMPL is a 5kw, 3-DA station with studios in downtown Sikeston, and the transmitter located 4 miles south of town on Highway 61. We employ mostly GATES equipment in our studios and transmitter. Incidentally, KMPL operates with 500watts at night.

I have been approached several times by members of your club about airing special test programs for the benefit of the DX'ers who cannot hear us because of some other interfering station. First, the time required to plan a program of this nature, not to mention the inavailability of personnel, does not merit justification. Not that I wouldn't do a favor for your club, we are just not set up for this type of thing.
