Thank you for your reception report. I am pleased to confirm your reception of our AM radio station KPCR. Your report of reception corresponds with a test period I operated on the morning of December 20. My log shows transmitter on 1:00 AM. Station ID 1:01 AM music & tone tests and occasional I.D.'s until 2:30 AM, much of the time the carrier was unmodulated. Congratulations. Yours is the farthest east reception report I have received to date.

KPCR is a daytime radio station operating with a one tube transmitter, a Gates Vanguard II operating at 1,000 watts with a 337 foot antenna at full efficiency.

Thank you for the photo. I'm sending you one of yours truly with the Vanguard II. Also I'm happy to send you a few items of station promotional printings we've had.
