Dear Mr. Cooper:

First, let me apologize, on behalf of Radio Station WABG, for the laxity on the part of prior personnel in their failure to acknowledge your previous letters. Since I have been manager of this station we have never failed to reply to a DX-er when we were contacted relative to a verification of signal.

You mentioned receiving a verification about three years ago with a postmark nowhere Greenwood which you believed to be a joke from a fellow DX-er. Of course the latter is possible, but unless you have verified that fact, let me point out that any number of postmarks could be authentic WABG replies. You see, we are a multiple operation with seven stations now. Three years ago we had stations here, in Kosciusko, Mississippi; Kingsport, Tennessee; Roanoke, Virginia, and possibly a station in Huntington, West Virginia. We also have interests in Birmingham, Alabama. So you see, a roving engineer coming upon your letter, could have carried it to some other point in our organization for mailing.

However, be that as it may. I have checked our files without success, to determine the accuracy of your February 19th. 1950 check. Radio Station WABG went on the air around the 20th. of February that year, and I am sure you heard our equipment test runs. However, my files do not go back that far. And, since logs for three prior years are all that are required in our active files, logs for November 7th. 1950 have been stored or destroyed, and I cannot locate.

I regret that I cannot be more specific. I feel certain you should have had a verification at the time. Please be assured that should you hear our signal at any time in the future, it will be verified upon receipt of your notification.
