Dear Mr. Cooper:

I'm very sorry it has taken me so long to answer your letter. We've had a bit of personnel shuffling and new programming to work on, but here is your answer at last.

After reviewing your letter, I can verify that you did indeed hear Radio VIP. We are a Mexican owned station. Our call letters are X.E.V.I.P., we transmit at the AM frequency of 1560 at 10Khz. We broadcast 18 hours a day and have a direct telephone line with CBS in New York, carrying all the CBS programs - since we are an official CBS affiliate. Our audience amounts to some 500,000 people composed of bi-lingual Mexicans, Australians, Americans, Canadians, and English and European residents.

From time to time, about twice a month, we receive letters from people letting us know that they heard us. The most interesting letter to date is from a Mr. Svenn Martinsen in Norway, who along with the letter sent us a tape on which he recorded Radio VIP, and indeed the jingles I heard were some of our older ones.

I certainly hope that this letter is adequate for your verification needs.

We sincerly appreciate your letter and wish you continued success in the future with your hobby.
