So this is our QSL. Sorry XEXQ does not issues QSL cards. We do not have any coverage map. Our power is 250 watts. Xmitter is a Gates and os located outway of 80 higway. Studios are at University heights, and staff is formed with s-tudents. Sometimes I use to be at mike. In 1958 and 59 I had a regular program with science news. Present shedule is Mon. tru Sat. from -- 10:00 AM and sign off at 23:00; Sundays is from 07:00 to 19:00 and our time is the same as CST.

XEXQ is hold in operation by the St. Louis University. All its programs are cultural type, pro-music, clasic, science, literature, teathre conferences with many performances of University students, opera etc. etc.

XEXQ was first station in this city. Also was first cultural station out of Mexico City. Ra--dio Universidad went to air by the first time - on July 28 1938. Xmitter was a gift of the then Prseident Gral. Lázaro Cárdenas, was home made and ranged about 100 watts and was located at - University heights. Since its type we have not any commercial ad. Once in a while we announce the various Baãls of University Schools, conferences, symposiums, and all activities conected with the University.
