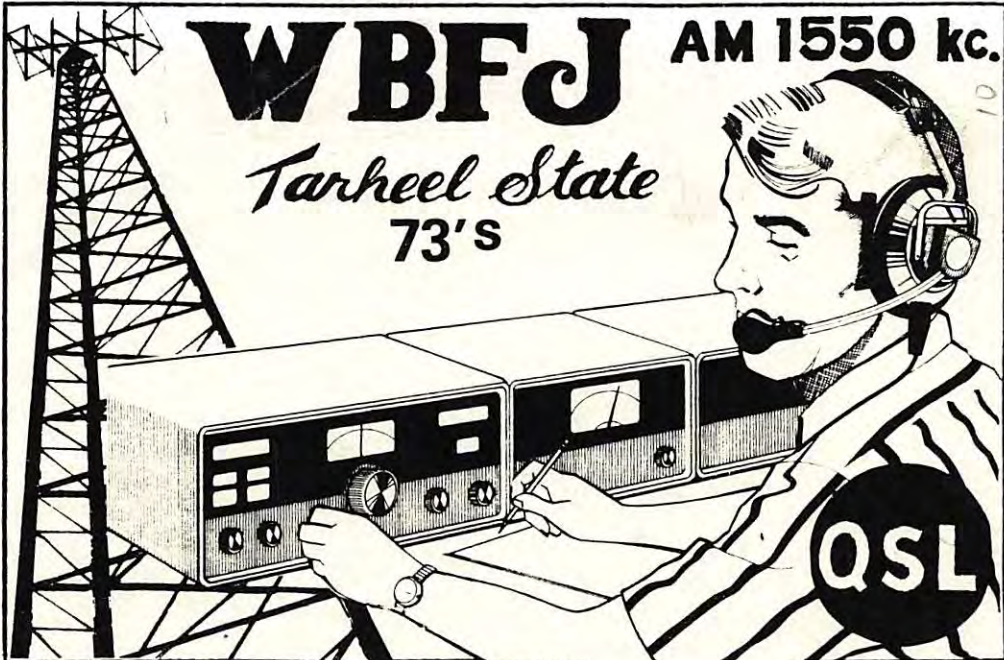

Dear Mr. Cooper:

This will verify your receipt of test signals from WBFO, Winston-Salem, N.C. on March 3, 1980. The tests were on audio compression levels, and were being done with all transmitter conditions normal. (1 kw, non-directional, at 1550 khz.) Normally, we only cover about twenty miles in any given direction, so you can imagine what a kick we got out of hearing that our signal skipped up to the cape! What's more, we were also heard at 3:09 and 3:28 AM that morning by NRC member Jerry Starr, in Youngstown, Ohio. Quite a good morning for skip on 1550, it would seem.

Thanks so much for your letter. I do a bit of really amateur DXing myself, and the letters from you two have me interested in NRC.
