Thank you very much for your informative report on the reception of our signal March 2nd 1964 .Your report checks with our log.

I was especially interested in your observation that the 1000 cycle tone did not modulate as heavily as our voice announcements. This condition has indeed been a puzzle to me. We recently installed a CBS Laboratories "AUDIMAX" for automatic level control, an instrument supposed to be flat in frequency response from 30 cycles to 20,000 cycles but for some reason it is definitely allergic to 1000 cycles. I have reported his situation to the factory but they seem to think I had a "screw loose" hi!

We have a new Gates 1000 Watt transmitter also a Gates 250 watt ~~XXXX~~ transmitter for emergency operation, facilities I don't believe many operations of our size can boast.


I was formerly a "Ham" as far back as the old "spark" days and in fact went to sea as Operator with the Radiomarine corporation of America when their ship were equipped with 5KW spark transmitters...so you see how ancient I am...I held three amateur station ^{LICENSES} 4-OY, 4-PO and 4-UF and earned a "worked all continents" certificate with only 5 watts of power

WLSE is ten years old, starting with only 250 watts.

I am enclosing a coverage map and hope you will enjoy looking over our part of the country.
