This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your DX report and to verify your reception of our station, on August 17, 1955, from 2:30:45 a. m. E. S. T. to 2:31:50 a. m. E. S. T. The tone you heard on 1480, however was not WWOK, as no tone was used.

WWOK first began broadcasting on January 18, 1955, our broadcast schedule is 6:00 am EST to local sunset. WE have a scheduled frequency check from 2:15 to 2:30 am EST on the third Wednesday of each month. WWOK is one of the Rounsaville Stations. The Rounsaville organization owns seven radio stations; WWOK, Charlotte, N. C., WMBM, Miami, Fla., WQXI, Atlanta, Ga., WBAC, Cleveland, Tenn., WBEJ, Elizabethtan, Tenn., WLOU, Louisville, Ky., WCIN, Cincinnati, Ohio, and has a management contract for WQOK in Greenville, S. C.
