came about in 1966, and we are now the "WIN-NUH" !
Our programming is 100 % "Up-town Country", and we
serve primarily Raleigh and Wake County, North
Carolina. The population of Raleigh is approxi-
mately 120,000, and the population of Durham is
approximately 80,000. Raleigh is the Capital of
the "Tarheel" state.

The WYNA studios are located on busy Hillsboro
Street, adjacent to N. C. State University in west
downtown, and our transmitter is located on Lake
Wheeler Road near the southwest city limit. We
use a Gates BC-1T transmitter, and a 243 ft./uni-
form cross-section/guyed/steel/series excited/base
insulated tower. Our power is 1.0 kw., daytime.
