Please accept our belated confirmation of your reception report for May 7, 1975. The information contained in your report substantially reflects information contained in our program log and announcer schedule for that date. The only complete conflict in your report of over an hour and fifteen minutes of listening was an ad for Skipper Motor Inn listed at 4:41.....at approximately this time we aired an ad for the Hatch Theatre....perhaps WBSM was sneaking in our your reception for a few moments at this point!

In answer to some of the questions you asked:

1. WASR first went on the air in April of 1970.
2. We are a primary affiliate of the American Entertainment Network (Yes, we do carry Paul Harvey 8:30a M-F and 12:30p M-Sa), and carry some programs from the American Information Network.
3. The population of Wolfeboro is approximately 3200 year round residents.
4. External frequency checks are normally done by Cambridge Crystals at approximately 12:05 AM on the fourth Wednesday morning of the month.

Since the time of your reception report we have made an adjustment in our programming. On May 19th, WASR switched to an easy listening format seven days a week. Previously we had been M-O-R Monday thru Saturday and Easy Listening on Sundays. Try us again....you might become a regular listener...even from Provincetown!
