Pretty terrible when it takes us three or four months to answer your kind letter of request for a reception report. I kept waiting for our engineer to be around here, but we at WAVI are "watched-out-for" by the engineer of our sister station, WARE in Ware, Mass.

I am the lady jock you heard on Christmas Day, and my usual shift is six to midnight weeknights, so that was more or less your ONE chance to tune ME in! We're on the air from 5:30 AM to midnight every day, save Sunday, when sign-on is 7 AM. Our directional signal changes at about sundown, and unfortunately (as I had wished we could skip down to Virginia, where my folks live) the night pattern is thrown Northeast, out over the ocean for the most part. We're only a thousand watts.

I love working in radio, too -- it's great to hear your story of "it's never too late!" I'm 25, and my fiancé (airname: Mike O'Neal)

and I love to tune around seeking the various stations, as you do, but we've never collected verifications as you have. I sure hope this will serve, and that you'll let us know if you're able to hear us again. Our format is '50's and '60's oldies, and our staff on the air
