Dear Mr. Cooper:

This is to varify your reception of WEMJ, Laconia, New Hampshire. WEMJ regularly broadcasts from 0600 hours to 2315 hours on the frequency of 1490 kilocycles. We have a daytime power of 1,000 watts and a nightttime power of 250 watts.

We began broadcasting on April 9th, 1961 at 1228 hours.


We normally conduct frequency tests with Cambridge Crystals of Cambridge, Mass., on every other month. Our next frequency check will be held on Thursday, November 16, 1961 at approximately 0020 hours. I would appreciate it if you monitor us at this time to please let me know. We will make the test on 1,000 watts.

You inquired about our call, WEMJ signifies the initials of our owner, Eileen M. Jaspert.

Enclosed is the only available coverage map of our station. It is our "old" 250 watt coverage area. To date, we have not published a 1,000 watt coverage map. We intend to do so shortly.
