This will verify your report to WTSL on the DX Run December 15, 1958 between 4:00 and 5:00 A.M. We have checked our program log and found your report to be accurate. (4:00-4:01:10-4:02:50-4:04-4:07-4:07:30-4:09:45-4:12:20-4:13:45-4:38:30-4:44-4:53). Thank you for participating.

I'm sending a coverage map as you asked and am certainly glad we could run the DX. It seemed to be successful so far, and I am sending the letters and cards for you to do with as you choose. Our frequency checks have been bi-annually, March and October, 1:00 to 2:00 A.M. from RCA. Since we are one of a chain (KBR-Manchester, N.H.), it will be up to them who shall handle our checks now. As yet, no word. We sign on at 6:23 A.M., Monday through Saturday, Sunday on at 8:00 A.M. All week we are off at 11:15 P.M. Our call letters stand for "Twin State Lebanon", The largest populated area we serve. The tower 153 feet high stands on the banks of the Connecticut River. As far as WDCR goes, they of course being a college commercial station, should be on the air all of the time, but they have vacations and are on and off throughout the school year and are also off summers (Quite a Set-up). Generally, when they are operating, their air time is 6:30 A.M. to 1:00 A.M. As they are 250 also, you might catch them on 1340 after we sign off. Frequency checks-Don't know....For the Newport Station-Rumor only-They should be testing by early spring. Yes, I did write a Promo for the Broadcast and included mention of the Club. We started running it at various times throughout the Broadcast Day on Tuesday, December 9th.

I guess that will just about clear up your questions. I hope I have given enough information to you and your members who were good enough to write us. I would like to say we felt the test was well worth the efforts.

Thanks for your interest in our Station. Looking forward to seeing you this summer.
