Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your reception report of **1160AM Star Country**. We are WOBM-AM, licensed to North Shore Broadcasting Corp., Lakewood Twp., NJ. Formerly 1170kHz at 5kW DA-1, we became 1160kHz 5kW DA-D, 8.9 kW DA-N as of July of 1988. We operate a 4-Tower array which produces basically a Heart-Shaped pattern with the major lobe at 165° from True North. The DAY Pattern also has a minor lobe at 350°, and the NIGHT Pattern has minor lobes at 80°, 252° and 345°.

**Star Country's** primary Transmitter is a **Harris DX-10**, which is a totally solid state, digitally modulated AM Transmitter, capable of flatly reproducing the entire audio spectrum, and even frequencies down to 1Hz! Ours was the second on line in the country. Since then, not only have many more been put into service, but the Harris DX line has been expanded to 20 and 50kW!

**1160AM Star Country's** Country music format arrives at the Station via Satellite from Los Angeles, CA from the Transtar Radio Network, a major syndicator of music formats. We feature live News updates at the top of each hour (simulcast from WOBM-FM, Toms River, NJ) 24 hours a day, and we are an affiliate of the NEW YORK METS Radio Network, carrying all 162 Regular-Season games, as well as the pre-season action.
