Glad to be able to confirm your report of reception of WACK early last Monday morning. Practically all of the several reports ahead of yours complained of WBSM from that area, or WHK from the West (All but one have come from the Met. N.Y.-New England area). You the first to report trouble from both these stations.

WACK is named after Aurthur C. Kyle, a Syracuse man who got the station started (in Oct, 1957). I managed to dig up a coverage map, which is enclosed.

We have three more frequency checks now scheduled, June 1, Sept. 7, and Dec. 7. This is as soon after mid-night beginning these dates as is convenient for the frequency service, who calls us.
