Dear Mr. Cooper:


Thank you for your letter of March 23rd. We did conduct a frequency check on the morning of the 23rd at 4:30 AM. We did use a 700 cycle tone with a station break every three minutes, therefore this would confirm your reception of our station at the time announced in your letter.

We are only 500 watts, with our main lobe in the NNW direction, and am rather surprised that you could get us at all. Our minor lobe come in to your direction, but the power is generally about 75 watts in that direction. We presently do not have a coverage map, but will have some printed soon.

Our operating hours are from 5:30 AM to sundown each week day, and 7:00 AM to sundown on Sundays.

I hope this information will help you in your work, and again thank you for your reception report.
