Anyway, this is to both confirm and verify your reception of WCRR-AM on the following dates: 9/21/81, and 11/22-23/81. We got your letter the day after Thanksgiving, and were quite tickled to learn that we could reach that far. Enclosed is our current coverage map. We're a 1000-watt, daytime AM station. However, we have been adjusting our transmitter for some time lately, and very soon, we hope to apply to the FCC for 5000-watt, 24-hour operation, so you may be hearing a lot more from us sometime! (Please keep this quiet, I may have said too much already.)

Now that the formalities are over with, we can chat. How are things in Cape Cod, in general? Both my new news director, Jim Wilson, and myself have been to the Cape at various times.
