Your report of reception of WDOE on 2/17/58
From 3:52 to 4:12 is correct as you logged it.

It may be of interest to you that we are a directional station with a power output of 500 watts. The daytime pattern is essentially in a north south direction and at night entirely north. Two towers are used during the day and three at night. WDOE is presently operating from a brand new plant on Willow Road here in Dunkirk where both the studio and transmitter is situated. The plant is modern and well outfitted.

We are located in Chautauqua County in the southwest corner of New York State on the Shores of Lake Erie. Dunkirk is a community of about 30,000 and is in the heart of the "Grape Belt". People from throughout the country find our location ideal for summer vacationing because of the pleasant climate and good beach and picnic facilities.
