Dear Mr. Cooper,

Thanks for your DX report. I keep a file of these, and you might be interested to know that we have been logged in Buffalo, Toronto, central Ohio, and the Thousand Islands.

Our frequency checks are made during the day, and since our equipment is only three years old, we do not conduct any regular tests, except the yearly proof, which will be done sometime in February. However, if you would send me a self-addressed post card, I would return it to you a few weeks before we run the proof, so you could tune in.

We have no accurate coverage map printed up, so just let me say that at a kilowatt on 1000, with an excellent radiating system, we get out, in the winter, about 60 miles or so, with 90 miles not infrequent.

As far as I know, I have no relatives named Richard, but on the other hand, I have never run across any family of Scullins (spelled thus) except branches of my great-grandfather's family, so it is likely he is some relation to me.

Until your report, I was most proud of being heard in Toronto, with CFRB on 1010 at 50 kw, but you rank right up there now.
