Thank you for your report of reception of WKSN, on March 9, from 2:45 to 3:04:30 AM. Your report conforms to our program log for that period.

It gives us great pleasure to hear from you again. You are doing very well in picking up five verifications from Jamestown, in as much as there are only two stations here, but that shows a good long line of DX experience. You certainly have a big list of stations you have logged.

WKSN operates at 1340 with 250 watts. Our transmitter is a Western Electric 451-A, and the antenna is a 150 foot self-supported tower mounted on the roof of the WKSN building in downtown Jamestown.

This station, as you know was formerly WXYJ, and was taken over by new management and ownership in December of 1963. As you said in your letter, we are known as "kissin radio". WKSN now operates 24 hours a day, except from 3:00 AM to 7:55 AM Sunday mornings.

Once again, thanks for your report. We are glad to hear from all DX'ers and all listeners. We have one member of your club, Dave Carlson, here in Jamestown, who we know quite well.
