To say the least, we here at WLFH, were very pleased to hear from you this morning. You mention our little experiment, that is, our staying on the air all Friday night. Well, a little one it was for we did not receive, as yet, any cards. We feel that this was due to two things. First, the atmospheric conditions might have been bad and second, I don't believe that too many DX'ers were aware that we would be on. Therefore, we would be more than pleased to put on a special program such as you mentioned. If it would be satisfactory, we would like to do it during the Thanksgiving or Christmas Holidays, preferably, the former. As these times are in the future, I am hoping that we can get together on a definite date later on.

Our regular schedule is 5:58 AM until 12 mid-night. We started on the air on Sunday, June 22, 1952, at 12 noon, with 100 Watts. Our change to 250 Watts was on March 31, 1953. There has been no definite time for our frequency checks lately because of some equipment changes here. As soon as a definite time is again set up, I will let you know. Incidentally, our schedule from our start until this past August first was 6 AM until 10:15 PM and the extension has been in effect since then.

I will enclose a card verifying your reception of WLFH. I feel that this would be more satisfactory than having it stated in this letter.

I have just spoken with the manager of the station and he would like the date for our DX program set at Friday, November 27th, 1953. I hope this time is satisfactory to you and your members. We will be happy to make it another all-nighter, if you wish.

Many thanks to you and your Croton associates. We'll be looking forward to hear from you and also for a big report on the 27th of November, that is, if this date is alright.
