Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thank you for your reception report. Yes, WYFA is no longer. The station is under new ownership and we made the change in call letters and format on July 13th.

Reception should be quite good where you are during early morning equipment tests. We had a reception report yesterday from Bradford, Mass. during our regular broadcast day. In the early morning, we have been heard at least as far as Norway.

Incidentally, I note your mention of 4,200 verifications on the broadcast band. Another letter received today (listening during regular hours in Chevy Chase, MD) claims 11,258 verifications in all, but only 2,479 on the standard band. But he's only been at it since 1946.

Our regular hours this month are 5:30 AM to 8:30 PM. Next month, 6:00 AM to 7:45 PM. The early morning equipment tests are normally made once a week, recently on Thursday or Friday night. I have enclosed a coverage map.
