Dear Ernest,

So sorry to have taken so long to respond to your last letter, but I have been very busy as of late. I hope all is well up your way and it hasn't gotten too wintery yet. I hope you have picked up some new signals since then!

Judging from the information you have provided, it seems certain that you did indeed receive WRCN-AM's signal on December 18 and 19, 1978 and again on October 18, 1981. Our AM station operates on the frequency, 1570 kHz, that you provided. At that time WRCN-AM's programming was simply a simulcast of WRCN-FM's. Our station slogan, at that time, was "The Album Station." The AM sign-off announcement did end with the phrase "Bye bye." I think that is proof enough.

I had planned to write this note on official WRCN-AM stationary, but our stocks must be depleted as I can't find any anywhere. It is quite a feat to receive our AM signal in Massachusetts as I can't even pick it 25 miles away at my house! I do hope that at some point you are able to pick up WRHD's signal as I think you would like it. The format is "Unforgettable", the music of the '30's, '40's, and '50's. Don't hesitate to write for anymore information. I hope this letter is verification enough. Best of luck!
