- AGREEMENTS HAVE BEEN REACHED ON THIS PERIOD.
 - 2. CLASS 2 STATIONS THAT WILL CAUSE A SPECIFIED AMOUNT
 OF INTERFERENCE WITH A CLASS I STATION IN THE U.S. OR
 ANY COUNTRY WHICH IS A PARTY TO THE NORTH AMERICAN
 REGIONAL BROADCASTING AGREEMENT.

WRSA IS A CLASS 3 STATION, AND WE DO NOT SHARE TIME.

HOWEVER, ANY STATION CARSING INTERFERENCE DURING THIS PERIOD
