
Hi Ernie;

This will verify your reception of WSCP Sandy Creek-Pulaski, N.Y. between 3:44 and 4:10 PM on January 10, 1975. A check of the log for that date reveals an ad for Goodsell Feed and Fertilizer in Richland, N.Y. presenting the weather, with their ads also during and after the weather. The other ads mentioned were for Lincoln First Bank and the Lacona Supermarket with 3 entrances (to their parking lot) from Harwood Drive, from I-81 access way, and from Cooper Street rather than 3 locations. Your listing of times for the ads is very accurate, most reports list only by even minutes and often are a couple minutes off.

WSCP went on the air in August 1974 with 1,000 watts and broadcasts Country music except for a request program on Saturday afternoons. WSCP all so carries many local school sports from Sandy Creek Central, Pulaski Academy, and South Jefferson Central. WSCP is located in a largely rural area half way between Syracuse and Watertown. Sandy Creek is a village of 700 population and Pulaski has 2200. Dairy farming, logging and lake shore recreation are the main industries. Pulaski is known as the Salmon fishing capital of the northeast.
