It is my pleasure to verify your reception report of our January 29th test program.

WSKN is located on the Glasco Turnpike in Mount Marion, New York with a combined studio-transmitter building. Although we are licensed as a Saugerties station the enclosed coverage map will indicate that we will cover a large market area including 500,000 people.

The station is RCA equipped with a two tower directional array. During the period you heard us we were operating with only the east tower excited on a non-directional test.


It is the hope of the owners that the station will begin regular operation about the first week in March. The programming will consist of mostly music and news. WSKN is not affiliated with any network or other station.

The station will be scheduling DX programs from time to time and will be happy to inform interested agencies in advance if they so request.

Our directional pattern is required to protect stations WJAR, WKRT, and WTTM. As the map shows it is also of advantage to us because it aids in placing our best signal in the larger market areas around us.

Saugerties, as a name for the community, is derived from Dutch, meaning sawyer.
