This letter will confirm your reception of
WTNY on Monday morning, December 13, 1982.

Your question regarding the changing of the
call sign from WWNY to WWTN can best be answered by simply
saying the FCC.

The station was owned by the Johnson Newspaper
Corporation who owned the Watertown Daily Times,
WWNY Television and WWNY Radio.

The Commission said get rid of, either the newspaper
or the television. Mr. Johnson was upset enough by
this order that he sold both the television and the
radio. Different companies purchased the stations and
since TV was the senior in this deal, they retained the
WWNY calls and we took the new ones. Hope that
answers your question.
