Dear Mr. Cooper;


Thank you very much for your report dated March 2, 1959. In regards to your request for two verificationsie AM-FM, it is not common practice to send separate replies because we simul-cast our broadcasts at this time. I am writing a combination report and if I can I will also write the separate one. At the time of this letter we are in the process of combining our studios and transmitter at 411 Fifth Avenue.

WVOX AM operates on a frequency of 1460 kc. with a power of 500 watts and WVOX-FM operates at 93.5 mc with a power of 1000 watts. We are part of the Herald Tribune Radio Network. At the time of this writing this network has been in existence 6 days, formerly the VIP network.

In regards to your letter's question about the time on the sign-off, you are correct, the time on Saturday night should be announced as 8 am. We have not had the time to cut a separate disc for Saturday night and I have to be content with this one.

Our programming is done locally from 1-2 and again from 3-5 Mon.-Fri.
