IN RESPONSE TO YOUR LETTER OF SEPTEMBER 14, 1987, I CAN CONFIRM THE RECEPTION OF WXXI-1370's SIGNAL IN PROVINCETOWN.

YOU HEARD PART OF OUR OVERNIGHT JAZZ PROGRAM, "THE THIRD SHIFT." AND THE 21st BIRTHDAY PARTY DESCRIBED IN THE BROADCAST WAS FOR OUR TV STATION, CHANNEL 21. THE FM STATION HAS BEEN ON THE AIR SINCE 1974; THE AM JOINED THE GROUP IN 1984.

WE'RE PRIMARILY A NEWS/INFORMATION/JAZZ STATION--AN NPR AFFILIATE, OF COURSE, WHICH NORMALLY COVERS MOST OF THE ROCHESTER METRO AREA, BUT LITTLE BEYOND. HOWEVER, OCCASIONALLY WE GET LETTERS FROM DX AFFICIANADOS--ONE CAME FROM NORWAY TWO MONTHS AGO. UNFORTUNATELY, WE DON'T HAVE A COVERAGE MAP TO SEND YOU; HOWEVER, THE SIGNAL IS HOUR GLASS SHAPED, WITH THE TOP END BEING ON THE LAKE ONTARIO SHORELINE AND THE BOTTOM ABOUT 40 MILES SOUTH OF ROCHESTER. THE "THINNEST" PART OF THE PATTERN IS JUST SOUTH OF GREATER ROCHESTER.

REGARDING THE EASTMAN WIND ENSEMBLE RECORDINGS...TRY WRITING KIRSTEN HAMPTON; SHE IS THE P.R. HEAD FOR THE SCHOOL, AND SHE WOULD COORDINATE SUCH REQUESTS.

THANKS FOR WRITING. BY THE WAY, THE REASON JOHN PROFFITT IS NOT RESPONDING IS THAT HE MOVED TO TEXAS ABOUT A YEAR AGO. I AM PRESENTLY THE AM PROGRAM MANAGER AND HEAD OF RADIO AT WXXI.
