

WYSL MAINTAINS A 24 HOUR SCHEDULE REMAINING SILENT FOR ONLY SIX HOURS A WEEK 12 MIDNITE SUNDAY UNTILL SIX MONDAY MORNING. AS FOR THE COVERAGE MAPS NON ARE AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME. THIS STATION SIGNED ON THE ARE IN 1936 WITH THE CALL LETTERS WBNY IT REMAINED WBNY UNTIL 1961 WHEN IN WAS PURCHASED BY THE McLENDON CORP. AND THE CALL WAS CHANGED TO WYSL. WE USE A DAYTIME POWER OF 1000 WATTS AND 250 AT NITE. WE OPERATE FROM A 279 FT. SHUNT FED ROOF TO TOWER ON TOP OF A 144' WAREHOUSE. THESE ANTENNA'S ARE NOTED FOR SKYWAVE.
