Dear Mr. Cooper:

This is to verify your report of reception of KVLH between 2:10 and 2:30 $\frac{1}{2}$  AM CST, February 22, 1948.

Glad that you were able to get enough to identify us. This is the last of a stack of over a hundred DX-reports and I am at home answering this so I do not have a definite list of sign-on and sign-off times, however we intend to operate standard hours signing on as early as our license allows up to 6:00 AM and as late as our license allows we will sign off, so a list of times for any daytime station in this area would probably apply to us likewise. We come on at 1:10 AM CST the third tuesday of each month for freq. check and broadcast for 30 minutes. Being a latecomer to this area I am not familiar with much outside of KVLH since I work on the mike all day and tie up loose ends in the engineering line at night, consequently I can't give you any info about KRHD in Duncan.

If you are unable to find out operating hours by the method I just mentioned, write me again and I shall answer your letter sometime when I am at the station and give you the exact times. Thank you for your letter and reports.
