Dear Mr. Cooper:

This will verify your reception of Radio Station KFJI (now KAGO)  
on October 9, 1953.

Klamath Falls now has a population of 21,000. KFJI first began  
broadcasting in 1924, and opened on 1150 kilocycles in 1951. Our  
directional antenna points east and west, and protects north and  
south. It is in use night-time only.

We would be glad to notify you if we had early morning equipment  
tests; however, the only time we are on in early morning hours is  
for periodic Conelrad programs of 15 minutes duration, about every  
6 to 8 weeks.
