Thanks for your letter of January 21, 1985. Sorry for the delay in reply. Bob told me he was going to get in touch with you two weeks ago.

I hope this will serve as a temporary verification of reception of Radio Station WBNW/WNAR. Norristown, Penna. Yes, we were testing both the RCA BTA-1M transmitters and 10-14 dB power reduction units. We do have some problems in the antenna system and a very unstable ground system. Thus we are now using the indirect power calculation method. Hope to correct those problems during spring and nice weather.
