Many thanks for your letter of May 29, regarding reception of WHEX, the morning of Thursday, May 10.

As you may have learned from your friend John Malicky of Pittsburgh, WHEX is a new A.M. station, having signed on the air Thursday, May 10, 1984, officially at 6:00 AM. What you heard was a transmitter equipment test and was our first actual broadcast.

WHEX has a power output of 500 Watts, 6 AM to local sunset, using a single 100 foot broadcast tower. The station acutally went on the air in the late 1950's, under the sign of WCOY. The call was changed to WHEX around 1971 and in 1976, the station went off the air due to financial problems. New owners, with new ideas and finances have taken over the old WHEX.

Today we are using the services of the Satellite Music Network, providing us with adult contemporary music and national news on the hour.

Thank you for listening to the new WHEX and for taking the time to write. I am enclosing a few items which you may keep.
