Sunday 0800


Perhaps unfortunately for DXers, but much to our

WWV on 5, 10 or 15 Mc. during the normal operation  
of WLEM.

We are about 140 Miles Northeast of WCAE.  
Unfortunately they do cause some QRM in the ST. Marys  
and Ridgway Pa. area.

WEMR rather suddenly closed its doors in October  
1956. After a Saturday sign-off, the owner came in  
and hastily removed the equipment. It was quite a topic  
of conversation among area broadcasters! Understand the  
commission knew nothing about the closing for some time.
