Thank you for your DX report of WOYK on October 26, November 2, 3, and 5, 1981. I have compared your program notes against our log, and find most of it to be correct. Some of the items that mention for October 26 do not appear to from WOYK. We do not have an announcer named "Joe", and the phone number 644-9421 does not appear to be from anywhere in our area. (Good luck on finding what station this came from!) The rest of your log is from our station.


Radio Station WOYK went on the air in 1932 as WORK at 1320 KHz. Then, in 1942, the frequency was changed to 1350 KHz, and in 1950 the power was increased to 5 KW. In 1973 the call was changed to WZIX, and on Thursday, October 22, 1981, WZIX left the air and WOYK came on Sunday, October 25.

Radio Station WOYK is owned and operated by the Baltimore Radio Show, Inc, which also owns WFBR and WBKZ, Baltimore, MD. The WOYK studios are located at 2 West Market Street, Third Floor, York, PA. Our transmitter is located in West York at 39°56'00" North by 76°49'06" West.

WOYK operates with a 5 KW non-directional pattern daytime, and a 1 KW three tower directional pattern nighttime, major lobe to the northeast. Our main transmitter is a Harris MW-5A, and our backup is an RCA BTA-5F. We operate twenty four hours a day, seven days a week.

Again, thank you for your DX. At this time, we do not have QSL cards, however, as soon as we have new ones printed, I will send one to you.
