This letter is to verify your reception of WQIQ, 1590 khz, on Monday morning, February 18, 1985 from 12:45 AM until 1:24 AM Eastern Standard Time. The information which was contained in your report agrees with what was broadcast and it is a pleasure to confirm your reception.


WQIQ operates from 5 AM until midnight, Monday through Saturday and from 7 AM until midnight on Sunday. Our transmitter is a Gates BCLH-1, with a Gates BCLG as an auxiliary. Our antenna system consists of 3 292 foot towers (5/8ths wavelength), non directional operation days, directional night. We operate with 770 watts from sunrise to sunset, 500 watt presunrise (6 AM until local sunrise) and 1080 watts night. During regular broadcast hours, WQIQ programs adult contemporary music with news and information for Delaware County (southeastern Pennsylvania). We also cover local sporting events, and on the weekend feature various programs from gospel music to big band music to rock oldies to 'Phone Talk Trivia'!

It was indeed a pleasure to conduct this test in conjunction with the NRC. The signal reached into Chicago and Ontario, and was even heard on the in studio monitor of WJSO-Johnson City, TN, who was kind enough to 'stand by' til their sign-on at 1:30 AM for their test.
