Dear Ernie:

This letter confirms your reception of this station on Sunday May 6, 1962. Your logging was fairly accurate. We will be unable to do a QX Test for you at present but perhaps I can later this fall or winter. We operate from 5 AM - sunset 7 days a week. We have no early AM frequency check period. Please remind me this fall about your Hunters Special and I'll see if we can't be on.

Shippensburg is a real old time town and its name came from a Colonel Shippen. It goes back to civil war days and this location was in the heart of the battlefield. Gettysburg is only a few miles away. The court house of this county was located here 1790's. And it is off course preserved perfectly.

You may have heard of me when I
was in Kane at WADP (1954-61). I did
an early test there for you. But I hated
that terribly cold winters there so I had
a chance to come down here and build this
place and work here. We are 40 miles
south west of Harrisburg on route 11.
