I was pleased to hear of your reception of our equipment test conducted during the night of January 15th from 4:19 A.M. to 4:32 A.M. The information you quoted in your letter concerning the program content is correct.

W.V.S.C. is a new station and commenced a regular broadcasting schedule on January 15th. W. V. S. C. serves Somerset County primarily, however, we also have a fair signal within a radius of fifty miles during daylight hours. Our broadcasting day begins at sunrise and ends at sunset, Eastern Standard Time.

At this time we have no regular schedule for conducting frequency check programs. Thanks for writing and I hope this information will be of some value as a DX item.
