Dear Mr. Cooper

I am pleased to verify your reception of our 50-watt AFRTS radio station here at Ramey Air Force Base, Puerto Rico.

I personally signed the station on, on 7 Dec 64, filling in for my regular wake-up man. Your log is correct. The taped sign-on was followed by five minutes of news. The first song I played that day was Peggy Lee's "Santa Claus is Coming to Town." This was followed by an instrumental and then a Liza Minelli number. Your 6:12 time for the second female vocal corresponds closely to that Liza Minelli number.

The call sign AHD has long since gone by the boards. We identify now only as AFRTS radio. Our sister station (which you mention) is in San Juan and is also a 50-watter. They identify as ACE and operate out of Fort Brooke.

It's nice to have a listener so far away, even if he can tune us in only for a few minutes on a Monday morning.
