¿May I call you Ernest? Thanks for your report of Feb. 3, 1975 of Radio Station WEGA (Radio Las Vegas).

We were kindly of surprised to know that our station was picked up so for as Massachussets.

Here is the information you request:

- 1) Gates equipment used, power output is restricted to 500 watts.
- 2) Directional antennes used (2 towers). Enclosed find chart that shows the coverage of out signal; as you can see, our pattern does not favor northern reception; so your report is of extraordinary value as these things seldom happens, and we use the field strengh meter every week at two different points to make sure the pattern is within specification.
- We have been on the air for 3 years now. Also, may I add that we have been granted night operation so, the phasor unit had to be modified for both day & night operation. Ussually we start operation sun set (6:00 A. M.) at sun dawn switch to night operation until 11:00 P.M.
