Dear Mr. Cooper:

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 12, 1955 in which you inform that you heard our frequency check held on January 10, 1955 from 3:58 till 4:02 A.M. when the carrier left the air.

You may use this letter as a verification of reception of W I S O on frequency check broadcasted in the abive mentioned date as it is correct.

You ask me to give some information about when we went first on the air, regular hours of operation and how often do we make frequency checks.

First of all I am pleased to inform that we first went on the air on September 15, 1953; that our regular hours of operation are from 6:30 A.M. to 11:00 P.M.; we have a power of 1,000 Watts non-directional operating on 1260 Kcs. and we use to make frequency checks with RCA Riverhead, New York, the second Monday of each month from 3:30 to 4:00 A.M.
