 ion.


Thank you very much for your interest in our Radio  
 Station.

This station operates on a daytime schedule and began  
 programming on April 12, 1961. Our directional pattern  
 extends 145 degrees true from our six tower array loc-  
 ated at B urrillville, RI, thirteen miles northwest of  
 downtown Providence. Our call letters are derived from  
 the roman numeral for fifty (L) and the KW of course stands  
 for kilowatt, thus WLKW (fifty kilowatts).  
 Our frequency checks are made during programming hours but  
 we oftentime have equipment checks from 0000 to 0400 hours  
 Thursday mornings.

Sorry, we have not yet received our coverage map but will  
 send one along when we get them. By now you may know that  
 our format is one of good music.

Your signal report was the fifth received by this station.
