Thank you very much for your fine reception report of June 9, 1979. I regret the delay in this verification but we have been engaged in many many changes here at WMYD and I have been very pressed for time recently.

WMYD is a 500 watt facility operating daily from 6 AM to local sunset. We radiate in an omni directional pattern employing a 112' tower located in Wickford Cove. At the time of your report we were a Raytheon RA1000 transmitter and on July 18 we switched to a Harris MW-1A.

As you noted in your letter our old call letters were WKFD which the station has had since beginning operation in 1960. The call letters were changed on the first of June following the purchase of the station by Acton Communications of Rhode Island who took the station over on May 10, 1979.

Once again I thank you for your reception report and I wish you the very best of listening in the future.
