This station now checked its frequency the last wed of the month at about 5 min. or so after midnight. It sometimes does not have the tone on the signal until after that. It depends on what time the freq. checking station call the station and are ready for the test, but I usually have some jusic of some kind on so the folks around can hear it instedad of a dead carrier.

I have just started working here. The fellow you met here as de is now in the consulting game. HI. I am also working at WWRJ 910 at White River Junction, Vt. That station isfreq. checked the first Sat. or rather first Sun. in the month, after Sat at midnight. I am already set up with NRC for a DX test on DEc. 28.
