I am in receipt of your letter of September 22, 1969 with your report of reception of WCVR Randolph, Vermont. Thank you very much for both.

Your log corresponds with mine therefore consider this letter a 'Confirmation of Reception' of WCVR Randolph, Vermont 1320 Khz on September 22, 1969 between the hours of 0041 and 0050:30.

WCVR Randolph, Vermont has been on the air only since December 1, 1968 with 1000 watts of power. The studio, transmitter and antenna are all located in one building about 3 miles east of Randolph, Vermont on a side hill. The transmitter is a Gates BC-1G using 833's as PA tubes and also as Modulators both stages being driven with 807's. The antenna is the usual vertical 200 feet high.
