Dear Mr. Cooper:

Thanks for the letter of November 24. Your log certainly indicates that you did receive WFAD on November 22. Every now and then, we pop into the most remote areas. A few weeks ago a fellow member of your club reported receiving us in New Jersey. Before WFAD started programming not quite two years ago, we were received in Philadelphia when operating the transmitter on high power for adjustment at three in the morning.

In answer to your question about early morning operation, as a rule, I do not do this since my frequency measurement is made locally. The only time I turn on the transmitter during the experimental period (after midnight) is when there is some trouble, and much to my satisfaction, this is rare.

Our regular hours of operation are from 6:00am to 11:00pm Monday thru Saturday and from 7:00 am to 10:00pm on Sunday. The hours of operation on high power (1000 watts) are from 6:45 am to 4:30 pm for this month. What makes your report exceptional is that you received us when we were broadcasting at only 250 watts.

Thanks again for the letter. If you get a few minutes, I would like to know about your radio club and the tuned loop antenna you used.
